

Work to begin as we pass the \$5 million mark!



THANKS TO THE GENEROSITY OF OUR DONORS SO FAR, WE HAVE SURPASSED THE 50% MARK IN OUR \$10 MILLION MAJOR FUNDRAISING CAMPAIGN.

We are about to start the crucial phase of actual construction. While the outside walls of the church will be preserved, the building will be extensively modified and the adjoining presbytery will be demolished. The remainder of the two-acre lot will be landscaped to create a large garden.

St. Raphael's will have 12 palliative care beds. Meanwhile, the day centre will be able to service roughly 20 patients per day, which is equivalent to 5,000 patient visits per year.

As of now we will be reaching out to the general public in order to achieve the \$10 million objective of our major fundraising campaign. The funds raised will cover all construction costs and the first two years of our operating costs.

We take this opportunity to express our gratitude to our donors and volunteers, thanks to whose efforts St. Raphael's expects to welcome its first patients in 2018.


