Maison St-Raphaël is a non-profit community organization that carries out its vocation by offering a 12-bed palliative care home and a day centre with multidisciplinary professional care and services—the first on the island of Montréal. We provide free, high-quality palliative and wellness care in one of Montréal's most populated areas to people living with an incurable disease. With respect and compassion, we welcome people from all walks of life, regardless of their social condition, ethnic origin, sexual orientation, gender identity, or religious beliefs.

Description

To broaden its representativeness and enhance its governance, Maison St-Raphaël would like to round out the skills of its collective profile. Board members must have:

- A genuine passion for Maison St-Raphaël's mission
- A track record of success
- An innate ability to work with others
- A willingness to take part in fundraising (board members must make Maison St-Raphaël "one of their top philanthropic priorities")

Expertise in one of the following areas would be an asset:

- **PHILANTHROPY:** Although a portion of Maison St-Raphaël's operating costs is covered by public funding, more than half its budget relies on community support.
- **LEGAL EXPERTISE:** As a non-profit organization, Maison St-Raphaël would like to be able to depend on adequate analysis of the legal issues arising from its operations.
- **HUMAN RESOURCES:** Since staff members ensure Maison St-Raphaël's excellent reputation, cutting-edge human resources expertise is a must for Maison St-Raphaël.
- **FINANCE:** The board must be able to draw on the expertise of the Finance and Audit Committee to advise executive management and issue financial recommendations.
